Activities:

- Discuss what they want to be when they grow up.
- Children take photos of their Nursery.
- Go on a litter pick to show how we must care for living things and our community.
- Children to take photos of untidy and tidy areas using ipad or camera.
- Use Ipad to record a voice and children guess who it is.

Welsh Language Development (Welsh/Curriculum Cymreig)

Activities:

The day of the week

Mathematical Development (Maths)

Activities:

- Counting forward and backwards to 5.
- Looking at quantities up to 5.
- Look at subtraction within 5.
- Explore length, height, weight and capacity using blocks, rulers, water. Create class height chart.
- Play instruction game for children to follow: 3 steps forward, turn around, 4 steps back, etc.
- Explore shape by creating a vehicle: go on a shape hunt around the Nursery.

Language, Literacy and Communication

Activities:

- Small world and role play area to develop imaginative play.
- Listen to stories and nursery rhymes.
- Mark making: Pencils, shaving foam, chalk, etc.
- Children bring in photos of their family and discuss people or pets in the photos.
- Children bring in their favourite story to discuss.

Activities:

- Children draw picture of themselves and their family.
- Identify familiar sounds: dog barking, footsteps, keys, phone ringing, water running, etc.
- Create a heart using different materials to show someone who is special to them.
- Create paper plate of themselves.
- Understand primary colours- explore colour mixing with friends and handprints.

Activities:

Harvest

- Explore where our food comes from.
- Who helps us get food.
- Discuss why we should share our food: Harvest food bank.
- Taste different foods we find at harvest.

Activities:

- Children to play turn taking and team games.
- Explore how they have changed using key words: past, present and future.
- Children to use mirrors and discuss what is the same and different compared to their friend.
- Look back at people who help us, discussing parent jobs.

Activities:

- Manipulation of different materials by rolling, squeezing, mixing, pulling, tearing and by using other fine and gross motor skills
- Walk around the school and look for signs of Autumn
- Draw around themselves and discuss parts of the body.
- Go on a sensory walk around school grounds.
- Guessing game by describing mystery object: soft, hard, etc.
